Plan now to make a presentation on religious emblems to your unit. Encourage kids with a segment of this puzzle patch. Working on religious emblems is a perfect project for over the summer.



The Eagle Patch segment is currently available from P.R.A.Y. It is the fourth segment in the Duty To God Puzzle Patch series. These patches are on a four-year cycle. If you missed one, don't worry because it will come around again. If you're brand new to the program, start with the Anchor Patch (the kneeling Scout).

The key to the puzzle patch is the focus that it puts on Duty to God and religious emblems. Puzzle patches may be earned by both youth and adults.
